

Clerks Report September 2021

Noticeboards – The 3 x Noticeboards have been ordered at approx. £500 per noticeboard. Although HMP Leyhill have stated that there will be a delay due to shortages of oak

Highway Issues – I reported the following issues:

Downton Road – the majority of drains are blocked.

Bus Shelter opposite the school – repairs to the floor are to be carried out mid-September (currently there is a big trip hazard).

Gigaclear – are carrying out work as part of Gloucestershire Fastershire to install ultra-fast broadband (in conjunction with Gloucestershire County Council). Play Rangers event took place at Leonard Stanley Playing Fields on Thursday 12th August 2021, this was well attended and Kings Stanley Parish Council has contributed towards the cost.

Summer In the Park event was held on the Marling Playing Fields, on the 25th August – this was open to the children from both villages, but pre-booking was required. I have not received any feedback as yet.

Saxon Gate Picnic in the Park event – was sadly cancelled due to poor weather.

Anti-Social Behaviour – the Neighbourhood Warden and Police are patrolling regularly, following reports of anti-social behaviour in parts of the village.

Boiler, Pavilion – Repairs were carried out last month, due to air in the system.

Police and Crime Commissioner - The new Police and Crime Commissioner Chris Nelson is running a series of roadshows across the county during September and October. He is going to be talking about his Police and Crime Plan intentions and the Chief Constable Rod Hansen will also be at each event along with local police management teams.
