Move tender plants into a greenhouse or conservatory; cut back perennials that have died down; divide herbaceous perennials; prune climbing roses; last chance to mow lawns and trim hedges in mild weather; renovate old lawns or create new grass areas by laying turf; plant wallflowers to bloom with tulips next March/April, pinching out flowers that appear before spring.
