

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATHS MST 16 & MLS 25 STONEHOUSE &**  
**LEONARD STANLEY (STONEHOUSE TOWN & LEONARD STANLEY PARISH)**  
**STROUD DISTRICT ORDER 2020**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for Public Footpath MST 16 in the Town of Stonehouse from its junction with Public Footpath MST 13 extending in a generally South easterly direction for approximately 220 metres and then carrying on along MLS 25 in the parish of Leonard Stanley for approximately a further 400 metres in a South easterly direction to its junction with Public Footpath MLS 1 is satisfied that use of the Footpath should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

**CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 10<sup>th</sup> September Thousand and Twenty and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months and may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure Of Footpaths MST 16 & MLS 25 Stonehouse & Leonard Stanley (Stonehouse Town & Leonard Stanley Parish) Stroud District Order 2020"

**GENERAL**

2. Except for pedestrian access to properties, no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpath
3. The Footpath falls in Stonehouse Town and Leonard Stanley Parish in the Stroud District in the County of Gloucestershire
